Outdoor Opportunities for Youth

Pheasants Forever sponsors camps for young adults ages 12-15. These camps allow participants to experience many activities available in Iowa's great outdoors. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis, and limited to 70 participants statewide. All registration fees for Webster County youth attending these camps will be covered by our chapter.

Outdoor Journey for Girls: 1) July 13-15 at Hickory Hills Park near Dysart; OR

2) August 4-6 at Wildwood Hills Ranch, St. Charles.

This event features a large selection of outdoor activities for young ladies, such as canoeing and water safety, fish and wildlife identification, archery, firearms safety, shooting, camping and outdoor survival, game care, conservation and management, and much, much more.

Scholarship Program

Webster County Pheasants Forever sponsors a scholarship program for Webster County residents to continue their education in any major related to wildlife and/or conservation – two students are awarded \$1000 annually. Application forms should be at your local high school or contact Larry Linn at 576-7175 if you or someone you know is interested in taking advantage of this great opportunity!

Cost Share Programs

Webster County PF is here to help with all your habitat improvements. For those who qualify, we will:

- Cost share up to 50% of the out-of-pocket cost of shelterbelts, winter habitat, and wetland restoration.
- The chapter will provide native grass seed mixes at cost plus shipping for habitat projects via the Iowa Council's Native Grass Seed Program.
- Provide free corn or grain/forage sorghum seed for winter food plots.
- Pay \$125 per acre to delay the harvest of selected corn acres until March 1 of the following year and \$75 per acre for soybeans and milo.
- Provide free ear corn during winter to feed upland game birds.
